## Welcome to Glenmalure.

Nestled in the heart of the Wicklow mountains, Glenmalure is a unique location with small fields and hilly terrain. A challenge for even the most experienced farmer.

All the basic machinery needed to get you up and running are included, you also have two fully grown fields to harvest straight away along with lots of grass to cut to feed your livestock.

There is plenty to do, from growing and harvesting crops to tending your livestock (Cows, Sheep, Chickens and Pigs) to keeping the local community well stocked with grain, vegetables, wool, milk and pork.

Features include Pig mod, water mod, feed mixing station, night lighting, standard FS2013 crops, multi terrain texture, AI traffic, and the More Realistic game engine for an authentic feel.

Milk is collected twice per day from the farmyard or you can deliver it yourself to the dairy.

If you get some free time, you can take a drive around the many mountain lanes and just enjoy the breathtaking views and discover the many hidden areas included in the map.

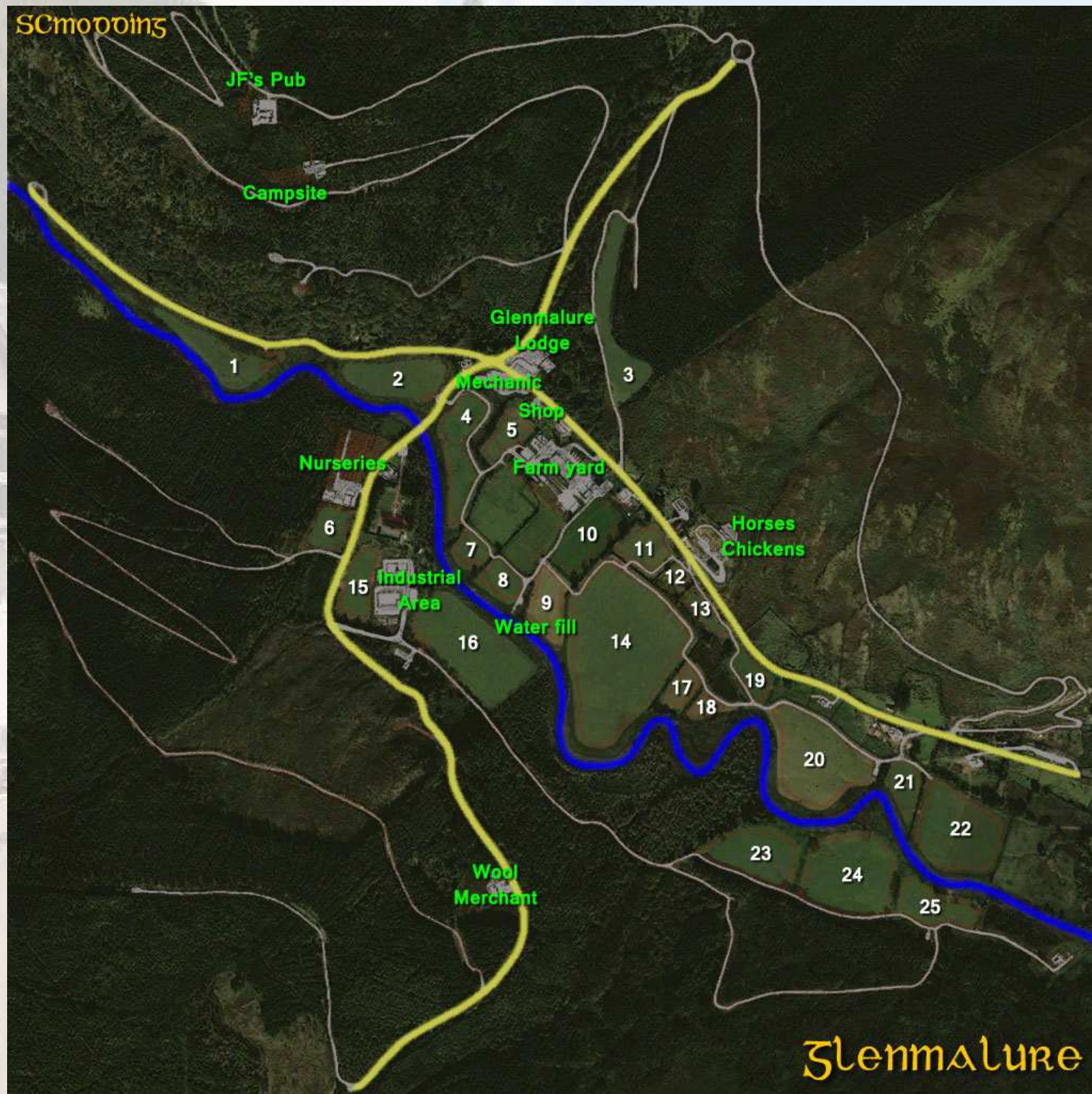

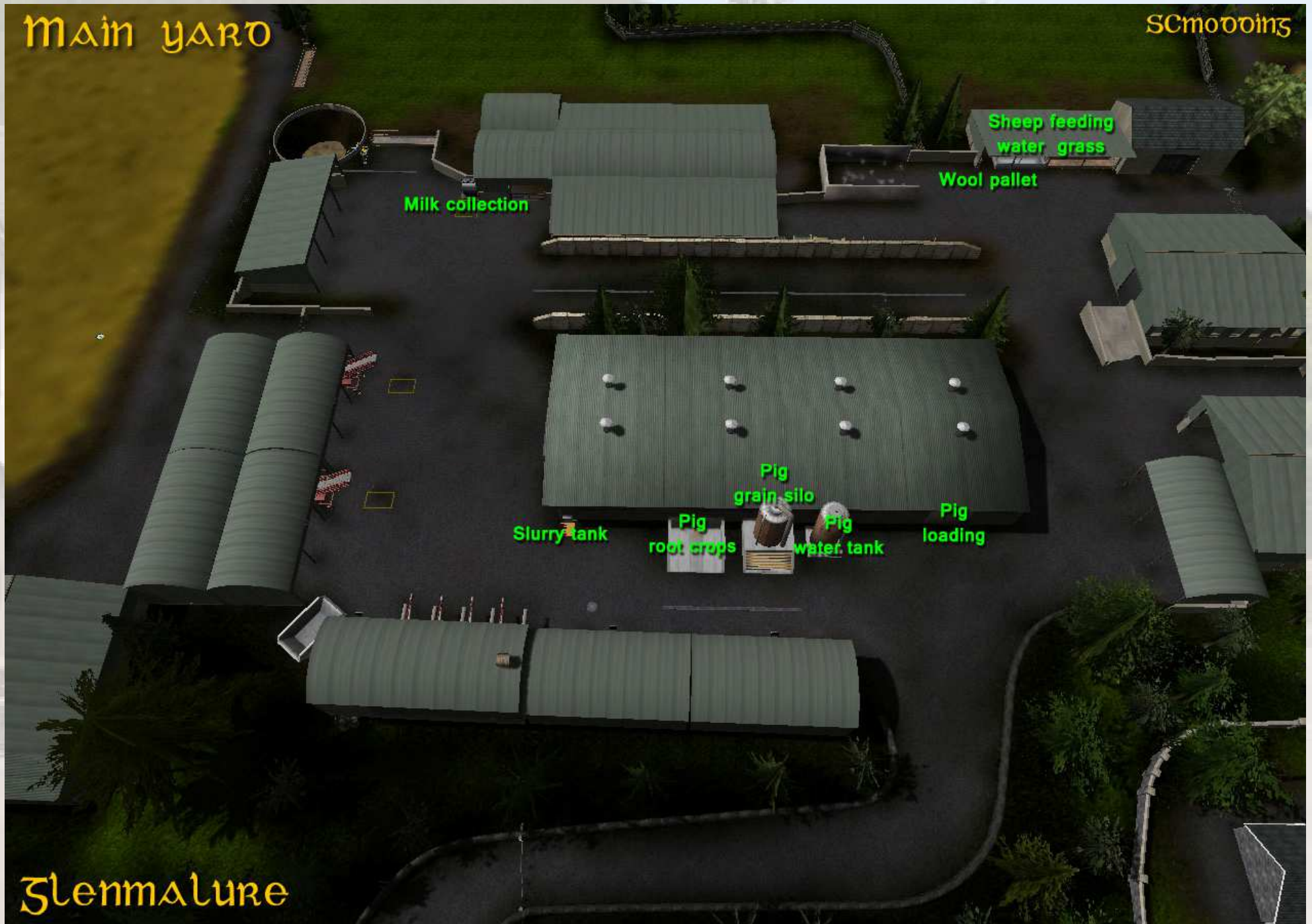

One of the many tourist amenities in the area, the campsite is very popular because of its amazing view of the valley, its proximity to many mountain and forest walks and, of course, it's only a stones throw from JF's pub.





## Glenmalur Lodge.

The Glenmalur Lodge is situated in the heart of the longest glacial valley in Ireland. It makes the perfect base for exploring the rugged beauty of Wicklow, also known as the '**Garden County of Ireland**'.





## Glenmalure Lodge yard.

Home of the local grain and vegetable dealer as well as a farm supply merchant where you can buy seed and fertiliser.  
Sell point for wheat, barley, rape, maize, potato, sugarbeet.





## O'Donovans Garage.

Mick O'Dovovan, the local mechanic, can supply you with all manner of tractors and farm machinery. He will also buy used equipment back from you – be sure to deliver it to him yourself for a better price.

Beside the workshop, you will find the only source of fuel in the area, his prices are always reasonable.





## Centra shop.

The local shop is run by Mrs Murphy, wife of the local wool merchant. She is very happy with the quality of your free range eggs and takes pride in selling them in the shop. Go to the rear of the shop any time you have some to sell and she will give you a fair price.

There is also a handy ATM available to check your finances.





## Glenside Group.

Glenside group includes an animal feed producer and a nursery. Started recently by foreign investors, it has grown steadily and is now a respected exporter of Irish produce to many countries in Europe.

Sell point for silage, forage, grass, hay, straw, barley, maize, chaff, bales and manure.





## Glenmalure Industrial Estate.

Here you will find a hub of local industry. You can sell milk at Avonbeg Dairy or alternatively, you can avail of their twice daily collection service.

Pigs that you produce can be sold at the Valley Bacon factory – a renowned local meat packer and major employer in the area.

You will also find an innovative new Biogas producer who can accept nearly any organic material and convert it into bio-fuel. The plant will accept grass, hay, straw, silage, forage, wheat, barley, rape, maize, potato, sugarbeet, chaff and manure.





## Murphy & Sons, Wool Merchants.

Peadar Murphy, and his two sons Enda and Sean have made themselves a tidy living buying and processing fleeces. Peadar has lived in the cottage at the crossroads all his life and along with his wife who runs the local shop, they are amongst the most respected people in the community.

You may have to haggle a bit as he drives a hard bargain but he always prefers to use local farms for his wool and you will get a good price here.
